

# Finance Real Livestock Transactions

## A reviewable transaction-finance model, not a public deal list

Regional Livestock Bridge (RLB) connects verified livestock supply, buyer demand, execution controls and transaction-level economics. Capital is considered against defined commercial transactions rather than general promises or speculative inventory.

### Opportunity Profile

**Active regional pipeline**

Commercial enquiries and supply opportunities are reviewed continuously across the RLB network.

**Multiple livestock categories**

Sheep, goats, cattle and camels are matched according to buyer requirements and market fit.

**Multi-market coverage**

RLB works across GCC, Horn of Africa, East Africa and selected regional markets.

**Controlled information access**

Buyer, supplier, price, route, quantity and payment details are not published on the public website.

### How a Financeable Transaction Is Built

1

**Demand qualification**

Buyer requirement and commercial intent are reconfirmed.

2

**Supply verification**

Supplier, livestock specification, availability and execution capability are checked.

3

**Economics and controls**

Cost stack, payment path, disbursement milestones, risks and repayment mechanics are reviewed.

4

**Investor review**

Qualified investors receive the appropriate Deal Passport and supporting evidence for due diligence.

**Public pipeline policy**

RLB deliberately presents opportunity information in aggregate on public pages. Exact deal data is reserved for qualified review so commercial counterparties and transaction economics are protected.

# Capital Protection Framework

| Payment control                     | Prefer stronger buyer payment instruments, controlled settlement paths or documented payment mechanisms appropriate to the transaction. |
| Staged disbursement                 | Capital release can be linked to verified procurement, inspection, documentation and logistics milestones.                              |
| Supplier and livestock verification | Identity, livestock specification, quantity, condition and availability are reviewed before key payment stages.                         |
| Deal-level accounting               | Transaction funds and costs are tracked at deal level rather than treated as undifferentiated operating liquidity.                      |
| Insurance and compliance review     | Marine, transport, mortality and regulatory requirements are reviewed where relevant and available.                                     |
| Repayment waterfall                 | The finance agreement defines settlement priorities and repayment mechanics for the specific transaction.                               |
